
Middle Grade – CH Discussion Questions and Light Lessons

The following questions can also be used as a PREVIEW to reading the chapter, giving the students a guide to look for certain information.

PART 5 AUTUMN

CH 24 LADY BIRD

1. P. 226 By now you know Mac’s trademark saying when he is about to tell a story: What is it? (“Here it is and here it goes.”) Describe the “ancient people”, and their “dark valley.”
2. P. 226 Why did the ancient people celebrate once per year? What happened when the celebration was over?
3. P. 227 What was different about the young girl? How did you feel when she did not come back from the mountain? How did you feel in the next year when she flew into the valley of the ancient people?
4. P. 228 Would you have climbed the mountain with the girl? Would you have tried to fly like the girl? Why or Why Not?



5. P. 228 How does Mac describe Dearie as the true Lady Bird? Do you think this describes Dearie?
6. P. 229 Why does Conor give Dearie a knowing look when she holds up her locket?
(Conor had talked Dearie out of pawning her locket – saying, “We have to believe. If we are fine, Jesse is fine.”)
